A critical control point (CCP) is a very important and essential resource, which is measurable. All CCPs must always be achieved. If a CCP control fails, production must stop until the CCP has been resolved.

Farm Conditions

- Assure the water is tested annually and placed in a location that is visible to employees
- Water needs to follow the same standards that the state of Wisconsin Grade A permit regulations for dairy farms.

Testing Protocol and Results

- Assure testing is completed, compliant with RAWMI Common Standards, and available for review.
- Milk testing to be completed by the 20th of each month.
- Milk test results emailed to RAWMI by the 25th of each month.
- If bacteria results ever rise above the RAWMI standard, the farmer then contacts RAWMI and/or another RAWMI listed member to consult and determine cause and retest until conforming test result is achieved. Assure compliance with RAWMI Common Standards.
- A licensed Veterinarian tests all cows of milking age annually for Brucellosis and TB.
- CCP, RAMP and SSOP will be posted in the store for every employee to review at any time.
- Farmer Chaz and no one else will extensively train any new employee.
